- From Adam to Abraham – 1 Chronicles 1:1–17 (20 generations)
- The family of Abraham – 1 Chronicles 1:28–34 (Descendants of Hagar, Keturah and Sarah)
- Esau's sons – 1 Chronicles 1:35–54

 - People in Jerusalem – 1 Chronicles 9:1–44

*** The Death of Saul – 1 Chronicles 10:1–10:14**

- See similar descriptions recorded here in verses 10:1-12 and in 1 Samuel 31:1-13 and 2 Samuel 1:4-12
- See a difference in verses 10:13–14 and the other accounts:
 - Saul died unfaithful to the LORD – not keeping His word and consulting a medium
 - Saul did not inquire of the LORD
 - The LORD put him to death and turned the kingdom over to David

*** The Reign of David – 1 Chronicles 11:1–29:21**

- David becomes king over Israel, conquers Jerusalem, his mighty men described – 1 Chronicles 11:1-47
- Warriors join David, others join David at Hebron – 1 Chronicles 12:1-40
- The ark brought back – 1 Chronicles 13:1-14
- David's house and family described; he defeats the Philistines – 1 Chronicles 14:1-17
- The ark brought to Jerusalem – 1 Chronicles 15:1-16:6
- David's psalm of thanks – 1 Chronicles 16:7-43
- God's promise to David – 1 Chronicles 17:1-15
- David's prayer – 1 Chronicles 17:16-27
- David's victories and officials – 1 Chronicles 18:1-17
- The battle against the Ammonites, capture of Rabbah and war with the Philistines –

1 Chronicles 19:1-20:8

- David numbers the fighting men – 1 Chronicles 21:1-26
- Preparations for the temple – 1 Chronicles 21:27–22:19
- The Levites, Kahathites division of priests, rest of Levites, the singers, gate keepers, treasurers and other officials – 1 Chronicles 23:1-26:32
- Army divisions, officers of the tribes, king's overseers – 1 Chronicles 27:1-34
- David's plans for the temple, gifts for building the temple and David's prayer – 1 Chronicles 28:1-29:21
- * David's Death and Solomon's Accession – 1 Chronicles 29:22–30
 - Solomon acknowledged as king–1 Chronicles 29:22-25
 - David's death – 1 Chronicles 29:26-30
